## POLICY

***TITLE IX - EQUAL ACCESS TO  
PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES***

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 prohibits sex discrimination in any school district which receives federal funds. The regulations cover all aspects of sex discrimination in schools with regard to admission, treatment of students and employment.

1. The Danbury Board of Education affirms its position that no person shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to, discrimination under any education program or activity.
2. The Board of Education will designate the Superintendent of Schools to coordinate all activities to assure compliance with all laws and regulations to assure equal access to programs and facilities and the responsibility for publicizing the provisions of this policy in an appropriate manner.

NOTE: The Danbury Public Schools will administer the regulations of Title IX which are printed in the Federal Register, Vol. 40, No. 108 (June 4, 1975), and effective July 21, 1975.
