Adult education refers to the school program and courses which are offered for residents who are 16 years or older and are not enrolled in a 9-12 school program.

The primary objectives of adult education shall be to prepare individuals for full democratic citizenship and to provide them with means for economic improvement and cultural awareness.

The Board of Education shall budget funds for mandated courses for adults such as ESL, citizenship, adult basic education, and high school completion programs. Participants in the adult education program shall pay individual fees.

All adult education programs shall be designed to meet the educational needs or interests of individuals in the community.
