The following units of credits (23) will be required to qualify for an Adult High School Diploma:

**Basic Studies**

English	4 units
Social Studies	3 units*
Math	3.5 units
Science	2 units
Art/Vocational Ed	1 unit
Electives	<u>9.5 units</u>
	23 units

\*Must include 1 unit in U.S. History and .5 units in Civics

**ACADEMIC CATEGORY**

Any credits earned and documented in a traditional school environment

**TRANSFER CREDITS**

From any accredited high school, college, or vocational/technical school, adult credit diploma program

**EVENING CLASSES**

No credit limit  
Each unit of credit will require 60 hours of direct classroom instruction

**INDIVIDUALIZED PROGRAM – COMPETENCY BASED SKILLS**

No credit limit  
Earned upon completion of independent work comparable to work done in a traditional classroom setting

<p><b><u>ADULT HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT DIPLOMA</u></b></p> <p><b><u>INDEPENDENT STUDY PROJECT</u></b>  3 credit maximum in required or elective area  Maximum 1 project in each required non-elective area  Project will conform to procedure approved by state guidelines</p> <p><b><u>MILITARY CATEGORY</u></b>  Credits can be earned for military service experience or training  2 credit maximum – elective area  1 credit = service time; basic training; other than dishonorable discharge  1 credit = documented special training program</p> <p><b><u>OCCUPATIONAL CATEGORY</u></b>  Credits can be earned for occupational experience or training  2 credit maximum – elective or vocational arts area  1 credit = either documented work experience OR demonstrated occupational skills  1 credit = valid occupational license  1 credit = documented completion of apprenticeship program  1 credit = documented job training program</p> <p><b><u>SPECIALIZED SKILLS CATEGORY</u></b>  Credit may be earned for life-skills  1 credit maximum – elective area  1 credit = documented community/volunteer service or documented skills in a vocational area</p> <p><b><u>GED</u></b>  A GED (General Education Development) High School credential is awarded by the State upon successful completion of all tests.</p> <p><b><u>EXTERNAL DIPLOMA</u></b>  The EDP (External Diploma) is awarded by the Danbury Public Schools upon demonstrating mastery of the 65 competencies required by the EDP Program</p>
