

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS – MIDDLE SCHOOL

LANGUAGE ARTS/STUDY SKILLS: *Course will focus on reading, writing, speaking and listening skills; students will improve their grades through improved study skills. Course will emphasize the following academic areas: English, Science, Social Studies, and Reading.*

MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH: *A skills-based math course which will emphasize mastery of learning objectives covered in the CMT and Middle School math curriculum.*

MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS may take either or both of these courses to fulfill requirements for successful middle school academic status.

PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

(APPLY TO BOTH MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS)

Absences: The nature of the summer school program is such that in order to meet course requirements the following attendance guidelines will be strictly adhered to. More than one unexcused absence in a two-week session will result in loss of credit; an excused absence must be of an emergency nature and will be granted at the discretion of the administrator. Vacation plans, transportation problems, and/or work will not be considered justifiable excuses. Any excused absence must be verified and the class work made up.

Tardiness: A student will be considered tardy if he/she is late to class. A student will be considered absent if he/she missed 45 minutes of class time. Three tardies, for attendance purposes, will be equivalent to one class absence. Parents must notify the summer school office (797-4872) if a student will be absent for any reason; otherwise, the absence will be recorded as unexcused.

Conduct: Students must adhere to the Discipline Policy of the Danbury Public Schools. Student misconduct will not be tolerated. Students may be removed from one or both sessions if the program policy is violated. Smoking is not permitted in school buildings or on school grounds at any time. Electronic devices are not to be used or seen during school day.

Transportation: There is not district transportation for summer school. Your child must be dropped off promptly and picked up promptly each day or risk removal from summer school program.
