WSMSA is a district magnet school that opened its doors in 2014. The school has two academies: one with a focus on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics and one for Global Studies. An overall theme of exploration, which will also be incorporated into the other two middle schools, ensures that students satisfy core curriculum while also being challenged to reach their fullest potentials. Students are encouraged and expected to problem-solve and be creative.

The school also offers world languages in Spanish and Mandarin. Students at the school have also participated in LEGO robotics and are mastering the skill of 3D printing. Extracurricular activities include a jazz band and a journalism class.

DANBURY MIDDLE SCHOOLS FAST FACTS

Eighth-graders have excelled on the Connecticut Mastery Tests: 89 percent were proficient after five years in the Danbury schools; this figure was only 62 percent for students who were enrolled fewer than five years.

In math, students also exceeded the state average with a score of 41, compared to the state's 36, according to last year's results.

For English Language Learners, students at the Danbury middle schools are outpacing the state in reading scores, growing an average of 47 points versus the overall state score of 34.

Danbury has the region's only STEM Middle School.

Broadview Middle School has award-winning groups that include the BMS media club and the Mathletes.

Danbury is the only district in the area that offers middle school students a chance to learn abroad: Rogers Park students taking Spanish II have the opportunity to travel to Puerto Rico.

Danbury's EXCEL program offers college prep to lower-income and future first-generation college students. Middle school students move up to ConnCAP/Upward Bound at the high school level. Student success has been proven in the program's high retention rate and rate of attendance at four-year colleges.
