Para/Tutor Substitute: \$80 per day, \$85 per day after 40 days in same assignment

Building/Cadre Substitutes: \$110 per day

THE DANBURY SCHOOLS

We have nearly 12,000 students in our 13 elementary, 3 middle, and one comprehensive high school. Two of our schools are magnet schools. One elementary school has an International Studies theme and our new middle school hosts two academies: STEM and Global Studies. The magnet middle school is the first district school to offer Mandarin Chinese.

Danbury High School has a Freshman Academy ("a school within a school") to help students transition easily. DHS offers 230 different courses, 57 athletic teams, 26 clubs, and a Junior Aerospace ROTC program.

The district also takes great pride in its Alternative Center for Excellence (ACE), a community-connected alternative high school, and its rich Adult Education programming.
